1.	feet. (17F) Team benches are 12 feet back from the sideline. We should move them to six
2.	(T/F) Benches start at the 10 foot line extended.
3.	(T/F) Players can stand behind the bench and watch the match, but cannot stand at the end of the bench.
4.	(T/F) The score keeper should sit to the left or right of the centerline of the court, not over it.
5.	(T/F) A flag hanging from the ceiling is playable and not part of the ceiling.
6.	(T/F) We do NOT tape across mascots on the floor, but when we take the test, we do.
7.	$\underline{\hspace{1cm}}$ (T/F) The referee's stand does not have to be padded higher than the level where the R1's feet go.
8.	(T/F) A school can write their name or sell advertising across the top of the net tape, but may not have it on the side of the net.
9.	(T/F) The net is 7'5.5" for the girls' game and 7'11.75" for the boys.
10.	(T/F) There are no caps on sets in regular season matches, all sets to 25, win by 2, except the final set is to 15.
11.	(T/F) Visiting team calls all the coin tosses. Home team picks the bench.
12.	(T/F) Head coach must attend the conference along with at least one captain.
13.	(T/F) We declare the match forfeit if the home team refuses to deal with a spectator within a reasonable amount of time.
14.	(T/F) While the rules permit us to declare a match forfeit because of the conduct of a coach, in Nevada we do not and leave that decision to the school district and commissioner.
