

Questions 2 - August 2016

1. ____ (T/F) To signal a net call, the R2 blows their whistle, indicates direction of service, then makes the net signal, and then gives the player's number to the R1.
2. ____ (T/F) The R2 should make their signals on the side of the net of the team that committed the fault, but it is not mandatory.
3. ____ (T/F) The R2 may blow a play dead on a double hit fault the R1 cannot see, after first making a discrete signal to the R1 indicating the fault.
4. ____ (T/F) The R2 may blow a play dead on a back row blocking fault the R1 cannot see, after first making a discrete signal to the R1 indicating the fault.
5. ____ (T/F) The R1 may blow the whistle for a substitution if the R2 does not see it and the R1 cannot get their attention.
6. ____ (T/F) Only the R2 signs or initials the scorebook, the R1 never does, even at the end of the match.
7. ____ (T/F) Managers and trainers are not team members, but auxiliary personnel.
8. ____ (T/F) The match must start with six players from each team on the court. After that, a team can play with fewer, even to start a set.
9. ____ (T/F) A team captain can request a line up check, server check, time out, or substitution.
10. ____ (T/F) At the start of the match when the R2 checks each team on the court, they will point to the team captain, who will raise their hand to signal the R1.
11. ____ (T/F) The team captain may NOT request a verification of the proper server of the opposing team.
12. ____ (T/F) The libero must be designated by the coach for each set. It may be a different person each set.
13. ____ (T/F) Both feet of the right front player must be closer to the right sideline than either foot of the center front player at the moment of the serve.
14. ____ (T/F) A screen may occur when a group of players is close together and the ball is served over them. It may also not be a screen.
15. ____ (T/F) The team roster may include a libero as both a libero and regular player, but they must have the same number on both jerseys.
16. ____ (T/F) Each team's starting lineup may not be shared with the opposing team until after the two minute mark prior to the first set, and one minute mark prior to each succeeding set.
17. ____ (T/F) It is a time out penalty if the roster is submitted late or must be corrected prior to the start of the match.
18. ____ (T/F) The lineup must be submitted in serving order as it appears in the score book.

19. ____ (T/F) If a coach writes the a number on the lineup that does not exist or writes a number twice, the penalty to correct is administrative yellow to start the set.
20. ____ (T/F) Player 8 comes into the substitution zone, the R2 blows their whistle and acknowledges the sub. If the coach takes the player out of the substitution zone, the penalty is unnecessary delay (administrative yellow or red card).
21. ____ (T/F) Team A runs into the back gym during a time out. This is legal.
22. ____ (T/F) Water spilled on the court during a time out which cannot be cleaned up before the end of the time out is unnecessary delay.
23. ____ (T/F) Team A coach realizes that the libero is illegally on the court after the R1 calls for the serve. She has her server toss the ball into the air to get a reserve. The libero can then legally replace.
24. ____ (T/F) Only one sub should be in the substitution zone at a time, additional subs must be off the bench and in line to enter.
25. ____ (T/F) Coach calls for a sub. Player is still on the bench. The player is permitted three seconds to take off their warmups and enter the substitution zone.
26. ____ (T/F) The libero is replaced, then realizes it is their serve. It is legal for them to re-enter the match and replace the server without sitting out a serve.
27. ____ (T/F) While team A is subbing, team B calls a time out. Team A can sub again at the end of the time out.
28. ____ (T/F) If the libero is on the court at the start of the time out, they must be on the court at the end of the time out.
29. ____ (T/F) It is legal for players to substitute onto the court without stopping at the side line if the score keeper has acknowledged them to the R2.
30. ____ (T/F) If an illegal substitute is found on the court after three points have been served by her team, the opposing team receives the serve, scores a point, the three points are removed, and the proper player is put onto the court.
31. ____ (T/F) If the libero is found to be playing the front row, the penalty is administrative yellow or red card.
32. ____ (T/F) Seven different players may sub in for #8 during the course of a set.
33. ____ (T/F) A player may play in only one spot on the court during the course of the match (i.e., once you sub for #8, you must continue to sub for #8 throughout the match).
34. ____ (T/F) A team has seven players on the roster, including the libero. If one player is injured, the libero may put on a regular jersey and enter their spot.
35. ____ (T/F) Player 8 injures their ankle and is replaced by an exceptional sub in the first set. They may not return to the match.
36. ____ (T/F) Player 8 is has concussion symptoms, or is rendered unconscious during the first set. They may not return to the match, even with the OK of a doctor or trainer.

37. ____ (T/F) A team has 15 substitutions per set.
38. ____ (T/F) Team A has eight players. In addition to the six on the court, #8 has played for #30, and number #14 has not played. If a player other than #30 on the court is injured, #14 must sub for them.
39. ____ (T/F) Team A has eight players. In addition to the six on the court, #8 has played for #30, and number #14 has played for #20. If #50 is injured, the team must play with five players.
40. ____ (T/F) Team A had an illegal sub in the match, during which they scored 20 points. This is discovered after the ball has been contacted by the opponent for serve. The points stand.
41. ____ (T/F) A team is allowed 18 libero replacements during the match.
42. ____ (T/F) The libero leaves the floor as if to serve (behind the end line), realizes it's not their serve, and runs off to the end of the bench. This is illegal replacement, unnecessary delay.
43. ____ (T/F) There is no penalty for illegal libero replacement unless the replacement is not completed prior to contact of the serve.
44. ____ (T/F) A coach may call a time out to request review of an official's decision, and may approach the R1 on the stand. The R1 may reverse a non-judgement call, but may not review a judgement call.
45. ____ (T/F) Assistant coaches may stand to coach their team during live balls.
46. ____ (T/F) If the head coach receives a card, or any team member on the bench receives a card, the head coach loses their right to stand.
47. ____ (T/F) A coach must sit if a player on the court receives a card.
48. ____ (T/F) If a coach makes excessive requests it is unnecessary delay, if they are doing it to disrupt the match, it is unsporting conduct.
49. ____ (T/F) The R2 gives a card by blowing their whistle, showing their card and pointing to the person receiving the card, and then notifying the scorekeeper.
50. ____ (T/F) Disqualifications must be reported to the commissioner and the volleyball board, a coach must leave the gym, a player must remain on the bench.
