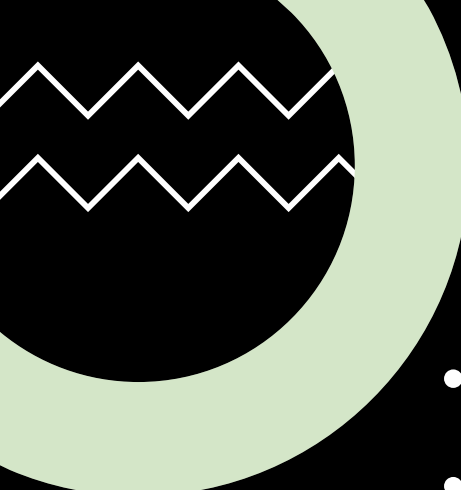

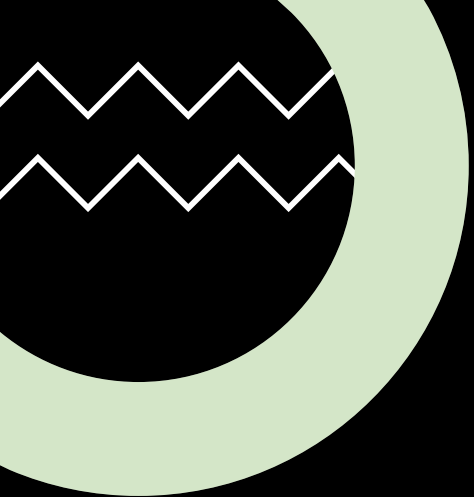

- R1/R2 communication
- R1 – Line judge communication
- R2 – Table communication
- R2 – Coaches Communication
- R1/R2 – Captain, Players communication
- Eyes open



Time outs, other stops

- **R1 – Pays attention!**
- **R2 – CHECKS the score**
- **R1/R2/LJs talk as necessary!**

- Each school **MUST** provide a libero tracker for all varsity matches

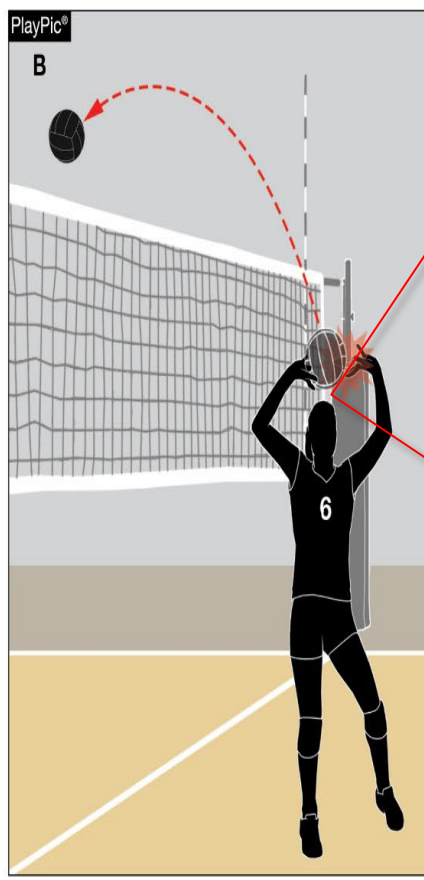
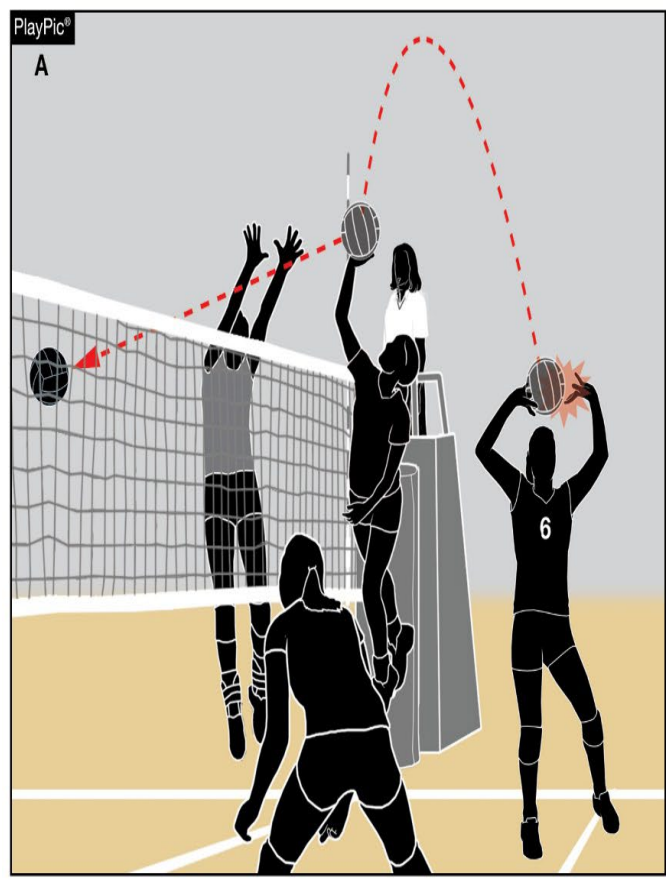


Contacting the Ball

- No multiple contacts faults on 1st hits
- No multiple contacts faults on 2nd hits, unless an opposing player contacts the ball or the ball crosses the net
- 3rd hits are subject to multiple contacts faults as the contact is made
- Jousts are legal and play continues
